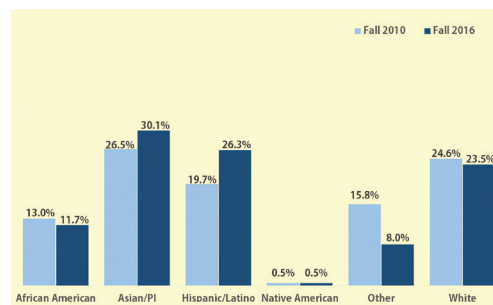

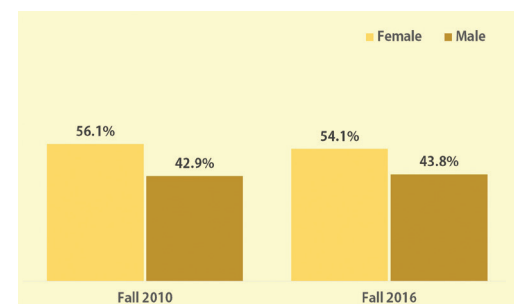

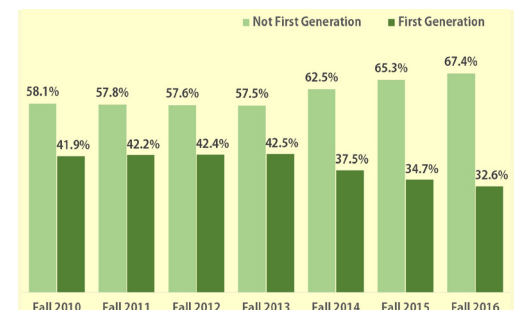
GENDER*

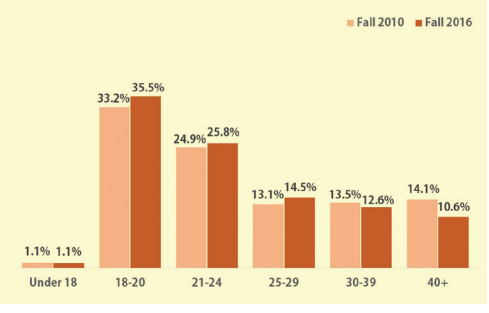

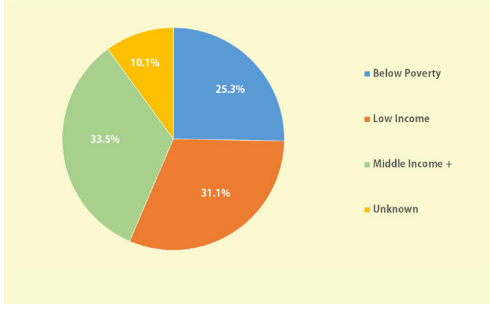

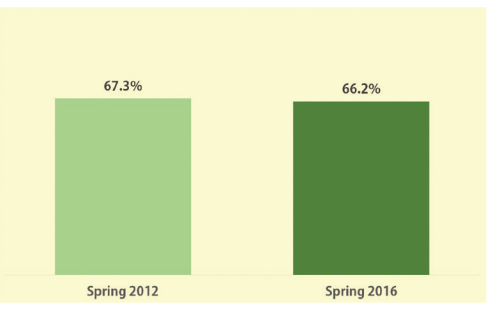

STUDENTS BY AGE GROUP



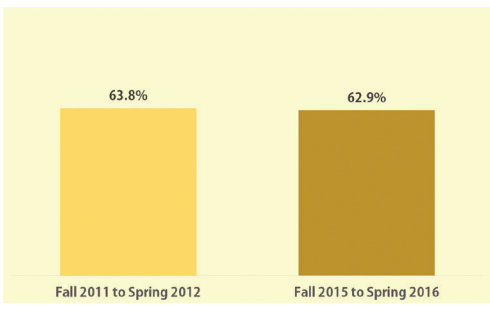
