The college is constantly finding ways to benefit the local community and we invite you to visit our campus and take a class or two!

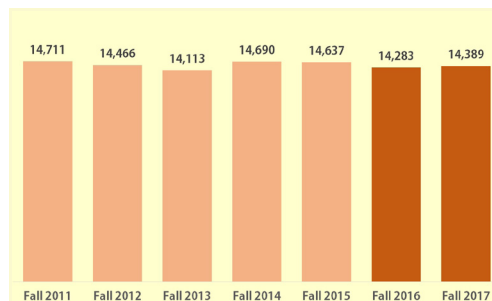

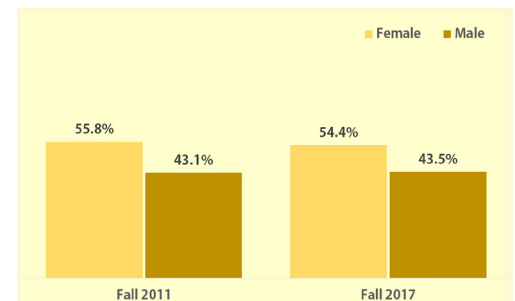

STUDENT PROFILE ENROLLMENT

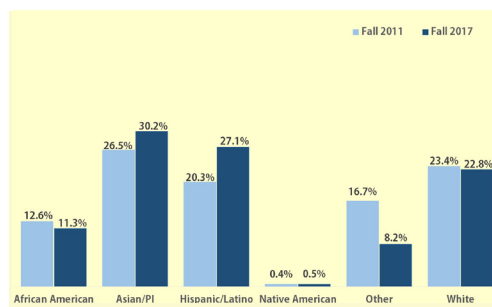


STUDENT PROFILE GENDER*

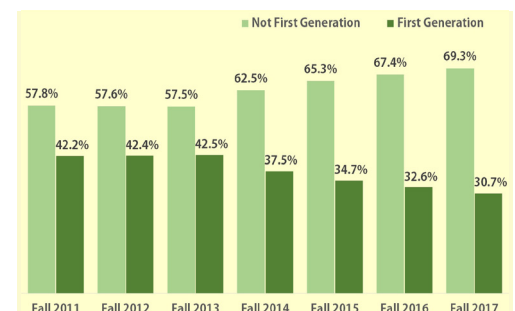

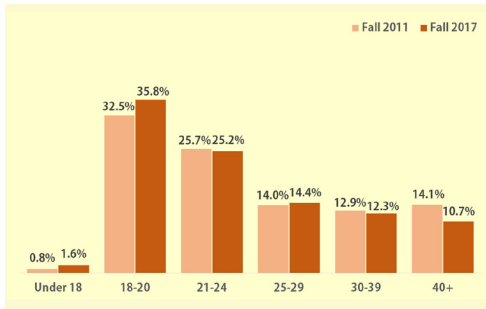

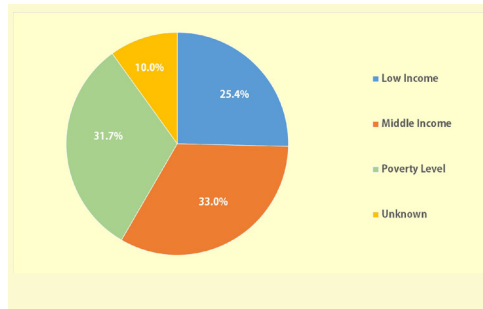

STUDENTS BY AGE GROUP



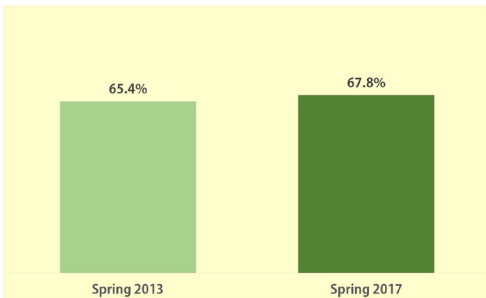

STUDENTS BY INCOME LEVEL



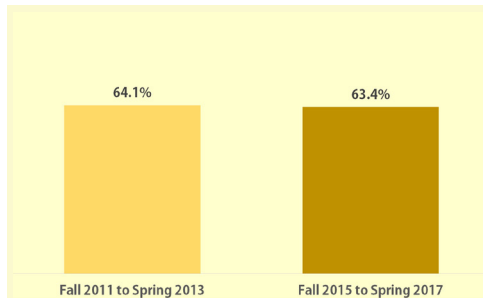
