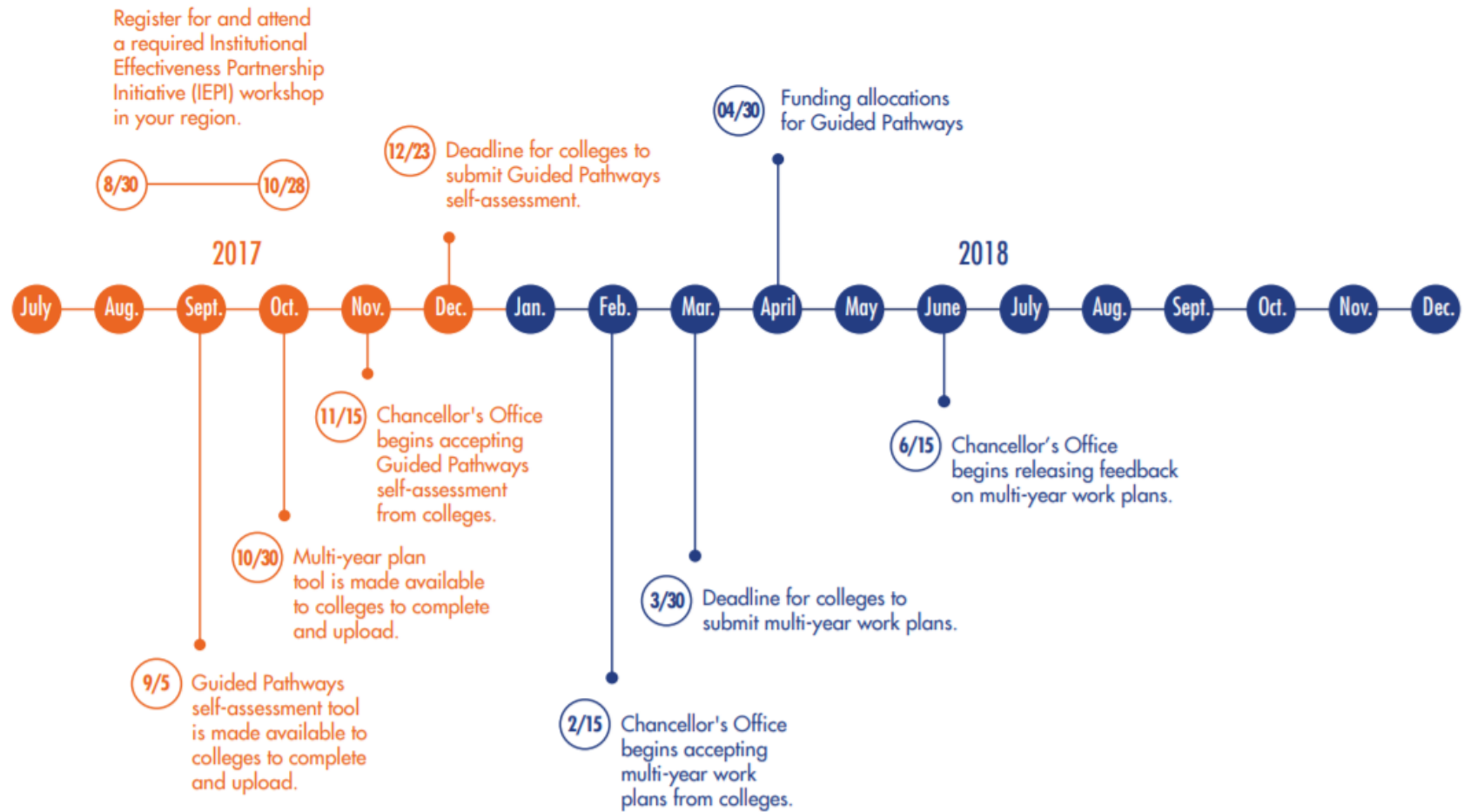


# CRC – Guided Pathways Self-Assessment for CCCCO Guided Pathways

- To receive funding, we must complete the following steps:
  - Attend IEPI Workshop ✓
  - Submit Self-Assessment: December 23, 2017
  - Submit Multi-Year Plan: March 30, 2018
  - 25% of total funding dispersed in the first-year: *tentatively* April 30, 2018
